National Child Protection Week is being held between 4—10 September 2022.

National Child Protection Week aims to engage, educate, and empower Australians to understand the complexity of child abuse and neglect, and work together to prevent it. The campaign does this through the sharing of events and resources to encourage communities to engage in conversations around children's safety and wellbeing.

During the week the teachers will be reading to the children some storybooks from the "SAFE" series. The Office of the Children's Guardian has developed the SAFE series – four children's books containing personal safety messages for children under six. The books support children's rights and promote the concept of kids having a voice. They help children identify the parts of their body that are private, help them understand their feelings and encourage them to think about five people they trust to help them if they feel scared, sad or upset.









Orange Blossom Festival

The annual Orange Blossom Festival is coming up on Sunday 11 September.

Kenthurst is the only part of the Hills Shire Council that still holds a street parade and it's a wonderful time for the community to come together.

Each year we invite preschool children and families to march with us from Kenthurst Primary School down to the Rotary Park.

The children love to be part of the parade and wave to the onlookers. Please put it in your calendar and get ready to come in your preschool T-shirts on that Sunday morning. Parents we will have some adult size T shirts for you to put on over the top of your clothes too!

There was a group photograph with the kindergarten children in the hall and then small groups were formed for a tour of the school by the year 6 students. The children visited the playground, the office, the Principal's office, the canteen and library. In the hall they had some dancing and some games and activities reinforcing concepts of colour, spatial awareness and coordination.

The visit concluded with sharing morning tea with the kindergarten children and a quick play on the equipment.
